It was projected that 75.4 percent of seniors would score above 50th percentile on senior test in 1999. The actual figure was 67.5. Only the Business Division (85.4) and the Social Science Division (75.5) majors averaged the university projection. Other division averages ranged from 70.5% (Science) to 48.4% (HPP). Business and Fine Arts exceeded 1999 projections; HPP, L&L and M&CS all fell more than 13 percentage points short of projections
