

Student Senate Resolution 011.008

In Support of allowing one LSP requirement to be taken credit/no credit
Presented by Academic Affairs

WHEREAS, Student Senate is the official governing body of the Student Association and exists to represent the present and long term interests of the Student Association in the formation of University policy and in the fulfillment of the University Mission; and

WHEREAS, The University is beginning to evaluate the LSP and the requirements that are needed to complete it; and

WHEREAS, The University seeks to create a culture that encourages students to explore topics that lie outside of their comfort zone; and

WHEREAS, Allowing one LSP course requirement to be taken for credit/no credit would encourage risk taking, stimulate academic exploration, and enhance the University's ability to operate according to its mission statement.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT, Student Senate support allowing one LSP course requirement to be taken credit/no credit; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Student Senate support the implementation of this change to the LSP as soon as it is logistically possible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Student Senate work cooperatively with the University in the pursuit of creating a learning environment that is consistent with Truman State University's mission statement.
