Whereas a honorary degree can be used to recognize outstanding achievement in a field, and

Whereas a honorary degree is one way of recognizing those who espouse Truman's values, and

Whereas, the judicious use of honorary degrees can enhance the long-term development of Truman by bringing prominent citizens to campus, by increasing the visibility of the institution, and by fostering support for the University, and

Whereas any honorary degree awarded by Truman would be clearly identified as such,

Be it therefore resolved that the Faculty Senate expresses its support to the Board of Governors for the awarding of a limited number of honorary degrees per calendar year.
